Cookies

Our website (www.nomos.digital) uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our site.

This Cookie Policy explains how Nomos uses cookies and other tracking technologies on our website.

This Cookies Policy should be read alongside our Website Privacy Notice which explains how we use personal information. If you do not accept our use of cookies, please disable them following our guidance below.

What are web cookies?

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive.

Although this Cookies Policy refers to the general term "cookie", which is the main method used by this website to store information, the browser's local storage space is also used for the same purpose and we may use other tracking technologies through this website such as web beacons. As a result, the information included in this Cookie Policy is likewise applicable to all such tracking technologies that we use.

What cookies do we use and why?

We use the following cookies

- Essential/necessary cookies. These are cookies that are required for the operation of our website.
- Consent banner cookies. These are non-essential cookies controlled by the consent banner and include cookies that track your visits to our website. For more details about the types of consent banner cookies used on our website please see the HubSpot website here. They include:
- Analytical or performance cookies. These allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our website when they are





- using it. This helps us to improve the way our website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.
- Social networking cookies. These cookies are used to enable you to share pages on our website and their content on third party social networking sites. These cookies may be used for advertising purposes.

Website cookie acceptance

By clicking accept tab/ticking box when you visited the website you have consented to our use of cookies as updated from time to time. In particular, you consent to cookies being stored on your computer and/or mobile device (unless rejected or disabled by your browser).

Turning cookies off

Internet browsers normally accept cookies by default. However, most browsers let your turn off either all or third-party cookies. What you are able to do depends on which browser you are using. If you do not accept our use of cookies as set out above, please click continue without cookies tab/don't tick box or please set your browser to reject cookies. However, please be aware that this may impair or limit your ability to use our website. The option to do this is usually found in the options, settings or preferences menu of your browser or mobile device.
